Terms and Conditions of Raffle

All raffle ticket entry(s) and additional fundraising contributions must be mailed directly to:
People for Clean Mountains PO Box 1624 Pisgah Forest, NC 28768 OR delivered to People for Clean Mountain designated person(s).

Raffle ticket payments by cash or check only, if check to: "People for Clean Mountains Solar Raffle Fundraiser".

Raffle entry forms are available for download and printing at www.peopleforcleanmountains.org or from designated People for Clean Mountains representative(s).

Each raffle entry form must be fully & legibly completed with required contact information including full name, telephone number(s), email address, and postal address. Multiple raffle tickets may be purchased, however each raffle entry ticket must be completed in full.

Raffle ticket purchaser(s) must be North Carolina residents and 21 years or older. Winning raffle ticket will be drawn at random from completed hard copy raffle ticket forms. With all raffle tickets sold, odds of winning are 1 in 180 / ticket sold.

Raffle winner is solely responsible for personal applicable tax liabilities, if any.

Maximum value of the winning ticket is \$15,000 (fifteen thousand dollars) applicable to an appropriate solar energy system at prevailing contractor competitive component and installation rates offered by Sundance Power Systems.

Solar system may be in any currently available form and comprised of currently available components for : 1.) solar photovoltaic ; 2.) solar domestic hot water; 3.) solar space heating or; 4.) combination thereof. Directly related solar system components, such as, but not limited to: wiring, mountings, controllers, batteries, pumps and monitoring are applicable to raffle funds available.

Solar system must be contracted within ninety (90) days of drawing and completed by Sundance Power Systems within one year of date winning raffle ticket is drawn.

Raffle winner must agree to: 1.) an onsite professional evaluation from Sundance Power Systems to determine functional suitability of solar system location and design parameters for estimated cost of system and 2.) Schedule said onsite professional evaluation within 30 days of winner drawing date.

Only directly related solar system components, servicing contracts, travel and installation costs from Sundance Power Systems are applicable. (For example, cost of a solar system installed on a garage roof is applicable, but NOT costs of building the garage or replacing a roof system prior.)

Location of intended solar system must be acceptable for installation regarding local zoning, covenants and restrictions, if any. If a solar system installation is prohibited, for example by a private homeowner's association agreement, Sundance Power Systems and/or People for Clean Mountains and/or Carolina Community Energy Partnerships are not liable, nor required to award a solar system.

Installation of solar system must comply with applicable building codes and structural requirements. Cost related directly to meeting such requirements for system installation from Sundance Power Systems are applicable to raffle funds available. Costs not directly related to meeting requirements for solar system installation are not applicable, for example, structural reinforcement of a sagging roof or existing sub-code electrical box or wiring system.

People for Clean Mountains will share the contact information (name, phone number and email address) of raffle purchasers with Sundance Power Systems and Carolina Community Energy Partnerships for solar system pre-qualification purposes. They can opt out of marketing communications at any point.

Upon signed contract between raffle winner and Sundance Power Systems, payment to Sundance Power Systems from funds held by People for Clean Mountains will be in accordance with their standard payment policy: 50% of the estimated total is due upon signing of the Agreement to Partner. 40% of the estimated total is due once work has begun on the project or in the event there is an excessive delay in the commencement of work, through no fault of Sundance Power Systems. The invoice must be paid before system start-up can proceed. 10% (the balance) is due upon system start-up. If there is an excessive delay, through no fault of Sundance, between project completion and system start-up, the job will be billed up to the current balance of work and materials.

In the event the final solar system cost is LESS THAN \$15,000 (fifteen thousand dollars), or available raffle funds, remaining balance will benefit People for Clean Mountains. For example, if a solar hot water system is installed for a total cost of \$12,000, the remaining balance of available funds will accrue to People for Clean Mountains.

In the event the estimated and/or final solar system cost EXCEEDS \$15,000 (fifteen thousand dollars), or available raffle funds, additional costs are the responsibility of the raffle winner. For example, if the raffle winner contracts for a \$20,000 solar photovoltaic system, any balance due above and beyond \$15,000, or available raffle funds, is the responsibility of the winner.

In the event of:

- 1.) Raffle ticket winner unable or unwilling to agree to the terms and conditions as outlined;
 - 2.) Desired location for solar system being unsuitable for appropriate solar system (such as unsuitable solar access, covenant restrictions, etc.); 3.) Raffle ticket winner's original intent to designate solar system to another eligible person and location
- 2.) Then, within forty five (45) days of the raffle drawing either:
- 1.) Raffle winner may designate a new raffle winner of their choice, contingent upon above requirements. Or 2.) A new drawing from all raffle participants, minus the original winner, will take place.
